Registration Requirements

1. Every work must focus on the theme of solar collection technologies of Concentrating Solar Power.
2. Entries must be original, never previously published, exhibited or awarded in any medium. Content must be truthful, lawful and free of advertising. No plagiarism or misrepresentation is permitted. Entrants bear full legal liability for any falsification, infringement or breach of law.
3. Entrants must be the authors of the works they submit and must hold an independent, complete, unambiguous and uncontested copyright in every element of each image. Individuals and organisations entering the contest further warrant that their works do not infringe any third-party rights, including but not limited to copyright, portrait rights, rights of reputation, privacy rights or trade secrets. Should these warranties fail and any dispute arise, the entrant alone shall bear all legal responsibility; the organisers reserve the right to claim compensation for any loss they incur as a result.
4. Works or conduct that violate generally accepted photographic standards or basic norms, or that are deemed detrimental to public order and morality, will be disqualified immediately. "Detrimental works or conduct" include, without limitation, any that seriously mislead the public, are fraudulent, or otherwise breach law, ethics, public order or good customs. The organisers accept no liability for any disputes concerning intellectual-property, reputation, privacy or portrait rights; such liability rests solely with the submitting individual or organisation.
5. Images must be submitted in JPEG format with a resolution of at least 300 dpi and a file size not exceeding 10 MB. Both colour and black-and-white photographs are acceptable. Entries must not bear watermarks, logos or multi-image composites. Excessive post-processing or AI-based enhancement will lead to point deductions.
6. Each entrant may submit only one photograph. A brief note (location, date, equipment, creative concept, etc.) must accompany the image. Titles are limited to eight Chinese characters; a compelling title strengthens impact.
7. Subjects must be solar-thermal power plants anywhere in the world, whether operational or under construction. Photography inside plants, of key processes or of technically sensitive areas requires the written consent of the plant owner.
