

Appendix 1: Entry Requirements

- 1.Entries must center on the theme of “ Concentrated Solar Power Heat- Collection Technologies” .
- 2.Works must be original, unpublished and have not won any prior awards. They shall reflect factual content, comply with laws and regulations, contain no embedded advertisements and involve no intellectual- property disputes. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited. Contestants shall bear full legal liability for falsified content or misinformation.
- 3.Contestants warrant that they are the authors of submitted works and hold complete, undisputed copyright over the whole and every part of each work. Contestants shall further guarantee that submitted works do not infringe third- party rights including but not limited to copyright, portrait right, reputation right, privacy right and technical secrets. Contestants shall bear all legal liabilities for any breach of such warranty. The organizer reserves the right to pursue legal remedies against contestants for any damages incurred by the organizer.
- 4.Any work or conduct violating generally- accepted photographic norms or public order and good morals will result in immediate disqualification. Such prohibited circumstances include, but are not limited to, material public misrepresentation and fraudulent practices in breach of laws, ethics, public order or accepted moral standards. All liabilities arising from disputes over intellectual- property, reputation, privacy or portrait rights shall rest solely with contestants, not the organizer.
- 5.Photos shall be in JPEG format with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi and maximum file size of 10 MB per work. Both color and monochrome photos are acceptable. Photos must be free of watermarks, logos and composite multi- image splicing. Points will be deducted for beautification using post- processing or AI techniques.
- 6.Each contestant may submit one single work only. A brief caption (shooting location, date, camera equipment, creative concept, etc.) shall be attached. Work titles shall not exceed eight Chinese characters; a well- chosen title enhances artistic appeal.
- 7.Photographic subjects shall be CSP power stations worldwide, both operational and under construction. Written consent from the power- station owner must be obtained for photography of on- site interiors, key components or any subject involving technical secrets.
